Trail: Zig Zag Spring Trailhead Kiosk Repair

Summary: The Blues Crew team worked to improve the trailhead kiosk at the Zig Zag Trailhead leading to the Lick Creek and Grouse Mountain trails.

Work performed

- Sanding, scaping and surface prep of the wooden kiosk
- Removal of staples and nails.
- Applied two coats of brown paint
- Install signs
 - Zig Zag Spring
 - Lick Creek TH
- Brush removal around the sign
- Placement of the Blues Crew plaque
- Blues Crew Rating Easy
- Total trail miles 0
- Weather Cool and cloudy – 50s
- Travel time to trailhead 40 minutes
- Transportation Volunteer vehicles
- Equipment provided by Blues Crew

The crew also hiked to the junction of Lick Cree Trail with Grouse Mountain Trail. Two issues were identified.

- At about 150' from the trailhead, large overhanging dead pine branches were identified as hazard for horse riders. They will be removed by the work party group on Oct 6th.
- The approach to the Zig Zag Spring was wet and very slick. One member slipped but was not injured. All agreed that a bypass section of trail should be considered. This proposal will be presented to the USFS staff.
